

Captiva Island Fire Control District Commission Meeting Minutes March 14, 2023

Call Meeting to Order

Commissioner Sims called the meeting to order at 4:01 pm. Commissioners Sims, Campbell, Brown and Chief Pawul.

Minutes from Regular Board Meeting

February 13th Meeting minutes reviewed and approved/ signed. Commissioner Campbell made the motion to approve, second by Commissioner Sims, no discussion.

Financial Statements

Financial statements through February 28, 2023 were reviewed and approved as presented.

Administrative Update

a) Personnel responded to 13 emergencies, 0 fire inspections were completed. Personnel compensated absences reviewed through February 28.

Operations Update

- a) Review the current process of FEMA reimbursement- initial review completed
- **b)** Property Tax refund- the amount the District may be responsible for is unknown until April when the requests are due to the Property Appraiser.
- **c)** Property values for FY23-24 are expected to drop 20-30% per the Property Appraiser initial estimates.
- **d)** Community Disaster Loan- Chief is filing applications and paperwork for FEMA Community Disaster Loan to see if we can qualify.
- **e)** 5-Year plan- Chief is working a new 5-year plan for the District. Draft will hopefully be completed by next meeting for review and direction.
- f) Performance review is underway with BJM consulting. Chief working to have the process completed in the next month or two.
- **g)** Financial audit- Chief is working with the auditing firm CLA to complete this year's annual financial audit of the District.
- **h)** GASB 75 report- Van Iwaarden and Associates and associates has completed the required OPEB valuation for District.
- i) Senate Bill 250- currently in committee, the bill would allow for a delay to complete the performance review and well as provide access to State funding in the form of a gap loan to assist with loss of revenue due to the hurricane.
- i) VFIS- District insurance policy is up for renewal, no major changes to the policies.
- **k)** Line of Credit with Synovus- all in favor of pursuing a LOC with Synovus Bank. Chief Pawul will further the process with Synovus with the option of up to \$750,000. Terms and conditions to be presented at the April meeting for review.
