Call Meeting to Order

Operations Update

a. Fire Chief

- Boat dock- Hans Wilson study- continuing to pursue options with McCarthy's and the County easement. The newest proposal is much bigger than originally planned, but does not infringe onto McCarthy's dock at all which would be better for both parties in the future. The County is going to review and see if it a viable option.
- FL Statute- 189.0694- requires us to complete an annual performance review of District operations based off District Goals and Objectives. This review is similar to

- what was completed last year by BJM. Our goals and objectives were already determined at that point, now we must continue that review annually by the end of the upcoming year per statute.
- Beach Flag warning system- Information has been sent to Lee County for review before we can implement.
- Triathlon Review- Triathlon went well. No major issues for the Fire District to contend with. We did see about the same number of incidents as in years past. We expect this event to continue in the future.
- Beach House restaurant South Seas Resort- The Community has identified a possible issue with an easement next to the entrance. This issue currently does not affect the Fire District, as we have and would continue that beach access easement to be designated as a fire lane for access to the beach for emergency rescue.
